## Teachers

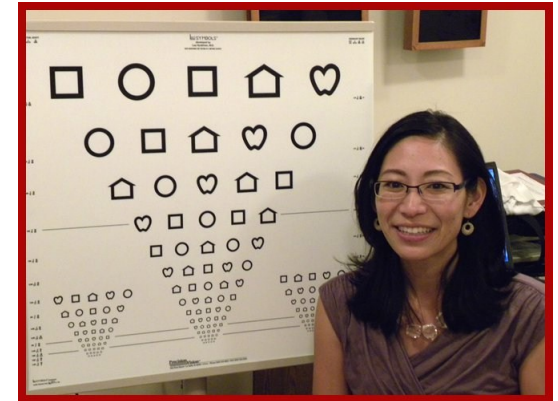
Our goal is to provide low vision information for educators as well as for students and their families.
